- I agree that, should a concern arise, I will first pray, then following the Scriptural guidelines of Matthew 18, will approach the person immediately involved. If necessary I will then address the issue with the Principal.
- If I become dissatisfied with the School in any respect, I will seek to resolve the matter with the person or persons involved rather than begin to spread criticism or hold negative attitudes in my heart.
- In partnership with the School, I will endeavor to "...train up a child in the way he should go", in accordance with Scripture (Proverbs 22:6).
